5th Annual Addison Jo Blair 5K Run/Family Walk

May 1, 2015

Dear Glendale Resident,

The 5th Annual Addison Jo Blair 5K Run/Walk will take place Saturday, May 16th at 8:00 am. This race will include both runners and walkers. The race will begin in front of the Glendale Christian Church and head down New Glendale Rd toward Gilead Baptist Church, where they will then veer right onto Smith Mill Road. The participants will travel down a short portion of Smith Mill Road before turning around and heading back to the Glendale Christian Church, traveling down the same path from which they started. New Glendale Rd will be CLOSED from the Glendale Christian Church to Gilead Baptist Church, as well as a portion of Smith Mill Rd from 7:30-9:30 AM. For this two hour period, you will NOT be able travel New Glendale Road and Smith Mill Road during this time: 7:30-9:30 AM due to the safety of you and the participants. In addition to having an official Permit on file with the Highway Department to close the road during this time frame, and being in conjunction with the Hardin County Sheriff's Office, there will be Kentucky State Police officers assisting at different intervals on the race path for added safety and precaution for both the participants as well as you. Again, we want to make you aware that you will not be able to travel this route on Saturday, May 16th during the hours of 7:30 – 9:30 a.m.. This notice is given two weeks in advance for those who need to make plans in advance to adjust your travel times. You may view the Official Permit by visiting www.addisonjoblair.org, click on the "5K Sponsor" tab, and you will see the attachment at the bottom. In the case of an emergency, the State Police will assist and lead you out of the race path when they deem it is safe to do so. The past two year's events have averaged 600 total participants and the safety of you and the participants is our number one priority. We need everyone to be aware and alert at all times during the race. We are making you aware so that every precaution is taken to maintain a safe and fun event. Also, race signs showing sponsors and pictures of children who have battled or are currently battling cancer will be along the race trail. The signs will be put out early in the morning and be picked up no later than 10:00 AM. If you have a problem with the possibility of a sign placed next to the road on your property for a couple of hours that morning, please feel free to let us know in advance.

The Addison Jo Blair Foundation is a registered non-profit organization set up to help local children who are undergoing cancer treatment at Kosair Children's Hospital in Louisville. Funds raised will go towards the Addison Jo Blair Cancer Care Center at Kosair Children's Hospital, CureSearch for research on finding a cure for pediatric cancers, needs assistance for families in need with children undergoing cancer treatment, and the Addison Jo Blair Memorial Scholarship.
